	Adult Education has 80 adults enrolled & 8 graduates.

6.2 Homeless Youth Education Policy	Homeless students have specific rights as outlined in the policy including families can stay at the school of origin. Cindy motioned to approve the Homeless Youth Education Policy. Linda seconded, all others approved,
6.3 Policy Against Plagiarism	motion carried. Linda motioned to approve. Cindy seconded, all others approved, motion carried.
6.4 Freedom of Expression Policies & Procedure	Cindy motioned to approve. Linda seconded, all others approved, motion carried.
6.5 Identification & Education under Sec.504	Extra support at school. Students with disabilities or special needs to receive equitable access, which could include a special chair or desk as example. Linda motioned to approve. Cindy seconded, all others approved, motion carried.
6.6 A-G Completion Improvement Grant	A writing workshop has been created for Middle Schoolers and a semester long class for High Schoolers to improve writing needed to be successful in higher level courses. Teachers can be paid Extra Duty Pay for after school tutoring. Stipend of \$5,000 for the A-G Advisor for this year. Linda motioned to approve, Cindy seconded, all others approved, motion carried.
